- Please bring your own face covering to wear when speaking with our veterinary staff and when entering the Practice
- Please continue to observe considerate and sensible social distancing
- Hand sanitising stations will remain available for client use
- Do not attend the Practice if you have symptoms which could be considered contagious, a positive test result or have been told to isolate.
